

Explanation of estimates for tuition and fees

Tuition rates are based on the nonresident rate plus mandatory fees. Special program, laboratory, and course-specific fees are not included. **Actual expenses will vary depending upon program and number of credit hours taken per semester.** For specific program fees, go to <http://bursar.iupui.edu> and click on “Estimate My Tuition & Fees.” Your academic program advisor can verify the number of credit hours required by your program for full-time status. Tuition increases are approved annually in late spring and may range from 8-10%. Summer enrollment is not required for many programs so are not included in the estimated expenses.

Dependents: Married students should anticipate costs of at least \$8,000 per year to support the first dependent (spouse or child) and \$5,500 per year for each subsequent dependent to meet basic needs of rent, food, clothing, and health insurance. If you plan to bring your spouse and dependent child(ren) with you, you must document funding for each dependent.

Tuition Billing

Tuition billing is done online at IUPUI after students enroll in classes. You will not receive a paper bill in the mail. Therefore, it is essential that you set up your IUPUI email account as soon as possible. Bills can be paid online with a credit card (MasterCard, Discover or American Express) through the QuickPay system. A "convenience fee" is charged for all credit card payments. Tuition Payment Dates

The due date of your bill will depend on when you enroll in classes. The payment schedule at <http://www.bursar.iupui.edu/duedates.asp> gives detailed information on payment due dates.

Pay attention to the registration deadlines each semester. An academic calendar outlining deadlines for dropping and adding classes is available at <http://registrar.iupui.edu/accal.html>. Late registrants must still adhere to tuition due dates, but will also be assessed a late registration fee of \$45 - \$100 depending on the time of registration. *You should plan to arrive on time so that late registration is not necessary.*

Tuition Payment Installment Plans

Mandatory Health Insurance Information

All students in F or J visa status are required to enroll in IUPUI's mandatory health insurance program for international students, unless sufficient alternative health insurance is confirmed by the waiver deadline. The cost to students for the 2011–2012 academic year is \$1038 per year, regardless of age. (Rates are expected to rise slightly for the 2012-2013 academic year.) Coverage begins from August 15 of one year and continues to August 14 of the following year; however first-time fall arrivals are covered from August 1. Students arriving for the Spring semester are covered from January 1. Coverage for dependents is required and is available at an additional cost. Exact premium amounts can be found at services.iupui.edu/health-insurance/students/. The International Student Orientation Program includes further details about the mandatory health insurance program requirements and coverage.

Student Account Billing

Student accounts are billed in two installments each year:

\$395 for the Fall semester coverage from August 15 through December 31 (billed in August), and \$643 for Spring and Summer coverage from January 1 through August 14 (billed in January).

These amounts are based on the 2011-2012 rates.

Waivers

Students with pre-arranged health insurance requesting a waiver from the mandatory health insurance plan must do so by the waiver deadline. To qualify for a waiver, you must submit the waiver request form, available through the iStart system at i.start.iu.edu. The waiver deadline is 10 days after the start of classes each semester. Students who do not file acceptable waiver requests with the Office of International Affairs by the deadline may be denied a waiver solely on the basis of late filing of the request. You must verify that you have medical coverage that meets the following requirements:

- At least \$100,000 lifetime policy maximum
- At least \$50,000 coverage for each sickness
- At least \$50,000 coverage for each injury
- Deductible not to exceed \$500 per sickness or injury
- \$10,000 medical evacuation benefits in the event of severe illness
- \$7,500 repatriation of remains to home country in the event of death
- Maternity benefits (female students only)
- Coverage which spans the entire billing period for which the waiver has been submitted.
